**6. Description of content:** Proposed rule - The Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) proposes to amend the <u>California Code of Regulations</u>, title 22, division 4.5, chapter 55, article 11, section 69511, and adopt section 69511.10. This proposed amendment pertains to the identification of a Priority Product under the <u>Safer Consumer Products (SCP) Regulations</u>, approved by the Office of Administrative Law (OAL) and filed with the Secretary of State on 28 August 2013 (effective date: 1 October 2013; OAL Regulatory Action Number: Z-2012-07170-04).

DTSC proposes to add nail products containing triphenyl phosphate (TPhP) – including nail coatings and artificial nails – as a Priority Product to the Priority Products List. This listing would apply to any nail product containing TPhP as an added ingredient, a residual, or a contaminant.
